PCZM Task Team tackles training, development and procurement



The Prieska Copper-Zinc Mine Project (PCZM) Task Team, which was nominated at the collaborative Bosberaad held last year, has continued to engage and progress on the execution plans at PCZM over the last two months.

The Task Team, which was given the responsibility of developing, implementing and monitoring the plan at PCZM, held breakaway meetings in May and June to focus on training and development and procurement at the mine.

Last week, the members received detailed information on PCZM's anticipated procurement requirements for the construction phase of the mine.

During the Bosberaad of 6 to 7 October 2021, targets were set for increasing local employment and procurement at PCZM. Specifically, the targets were to ensure 50% local employment, 30% local procurement and 40% contracting opportunities at PCZM.

Orion remains committed to reaching these aspirational targets for host community participation.

The next in-person Task Team meeting will be held on 20 July where the procurement stream and the training and development stream will be unpacked. Feedback and progress from this meeting will be presented at the next Orion Siyathemba Stakeholder Engagement Forum which is planned for 21 July.
